How do I apply? It's easy!

1. Apply online via the Saint Martin's application link at: www.uceverett.org
 - Application fee is \$35
2. Remember to select "Everett" as your extension campus
3. Everett Mechanical Engineering student DO NOT NEED TO WRITE AN ESSAY
